
Multilevel Risk Factors Associated with Child Abuse

- Young age
- Low education attainment
- Single mother
- Poor parenting skills
- Early exposure to violence
- Substance misuse
- Inadequate parental care
- Relationship problems
- Physical/mental illness

Child

- Poor supervision by parents
- High level of personal autonomy
- Gender
- Disability



Community/Society

- Social inequalities
- Acceptance of violence
- Unenforced laws

Family

- Poor socioeconomic status
- Overcrowded living conditions
- Social isolation
- High levels of stress
- Family abuse/domestic violence
- History of violence
- Alcohol/substance misuse
