# The benefits of Caring for Country in NSW

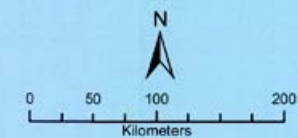

## QUEENSLAND



**E'ora** is a term that has come into recent use by some of the Sydney metropolitan Aboriginal communities to provide them with a form of discrete geographic identity. The term is derived from two words of the broader Dharawal language of the region and literally translates to mean "Yes, People"

**Yuin** is a term that a number of the south coast Aboriginal peoples' use as a collective term when referring to the various traditional groups between Nowra and the Victorian border. It is derived from the language of the south coast region and literally translates as "man"

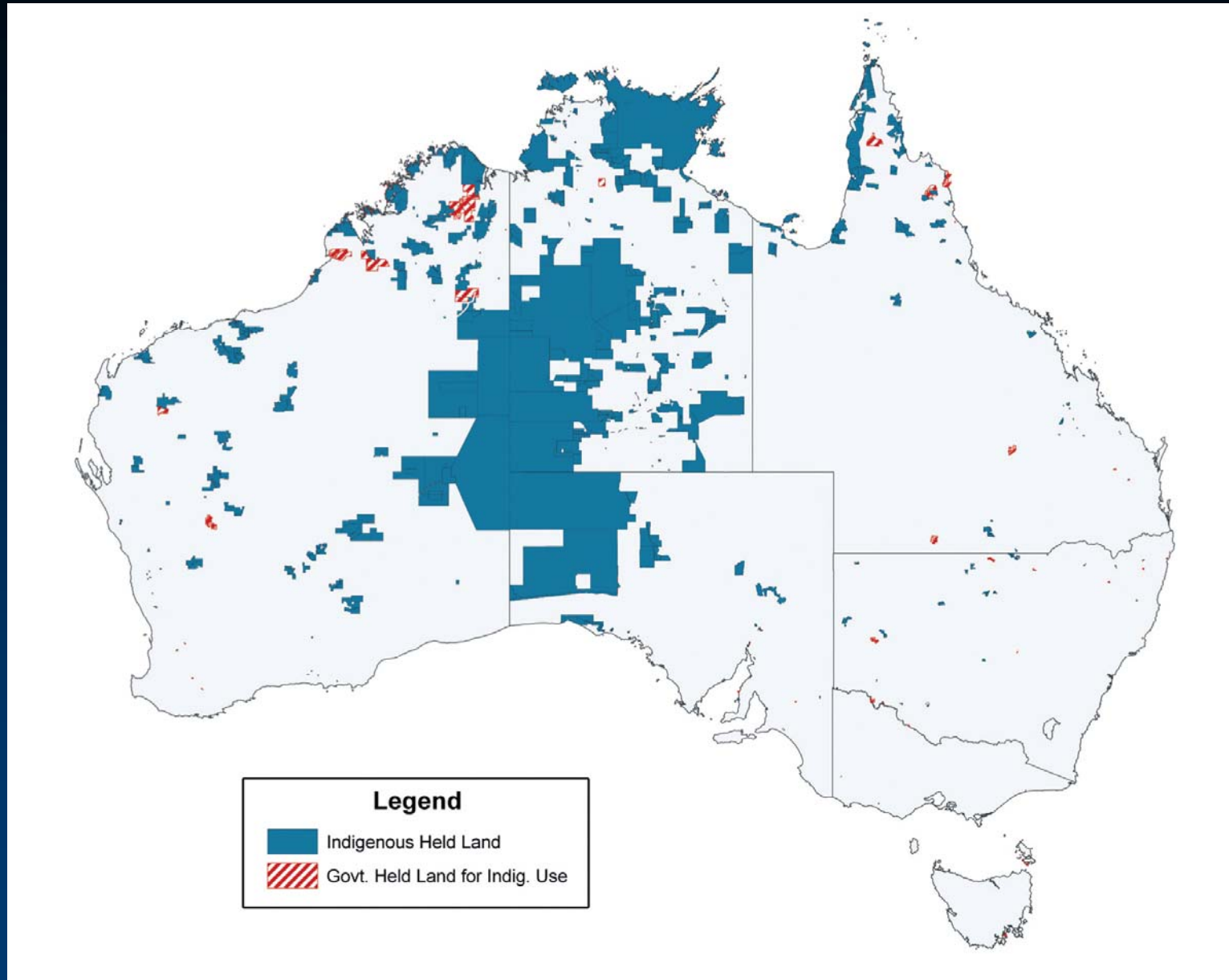
